## Bible Storyteller

### Session One

- 📖 Bibles and/or Bible App for smartphone/tablet
- 📖 Storyteller costume—This could be typical “Renaissance Fest” attire (billowy shirt, puffy hat with feather, etc.; tights optional). Modern attire also may work, especially when paired with a Knights of North Castle **Leader T-Shirt** and **Guide Vest**.
- 📖 Bible—The Storyteller could hold a Bible that looks very old and has fancy lettering. (Consider designing a “prop” Bible from cardboard so that it is lighter.)
- 📖 Bible-times attire for Musicians 1 and 2 and for Leaders 1 and 2—simple tunics or robes
- 📖 Bible-times attire for Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego—tunics or robes of a different color than the ones for the Musicians and Leaders
- 📖 Bible-times attire for King Nebuchadnezzar—purple or blue robe, crown
- 📖 kazoo and triangle for Musicians 1 and 2
- 📖 gold Statue
- 📖 Create a furnace using a cardboard box along with yellow, red and orange colored tissue paper or use Transparency 23: Scene 5.
- 📖 Knights of North Castle Complete Music CD or MP3 files
- 📖 CD player or device to play downloaded music













### Session Two

- 📖 Bible or Bible App for smartphone/tablet
- 📖 Storyteller costume—This could be typical “Renaissance Fest” attire (billowy shirt, puffy hat with feather, etc.; tights optional). Modern attire also may work, especially when paired with a Knights of North Castle **Leader T-Shirt** and **Guide Vest**.
- 📖 Bible—The Storyteller could hold a Bible that looks very old and has fancy lettering. (Consider designing a “prop” Bible from cardboard so that it is lighter.)
- 📖 Bible-times attire for Israelites 1 and 2—tunics or robes
- 📖 Bible-times attire for King Saul—same as Israelites 1 and 2, plus a crown
- 📖 Bible-times attire for Philistines 1 and 2—tunics or robes of a different color than the ones for the Israelites
- 📖 Bible-times attire for Goliath—same as the Philistines, plus a spear and an optional beard
- 📖 small platform—Consider providing a platform for the person playing Goliath so that Goliath can look more “gigantic.”
- 📖 Bible-times attire for David—a robe or tunic of a different color than all the others, plus a shepherd’s crook and a sling
- 📖 Transparency 23: Scene 5
- 📖 five smooth stones (These could be five wadded-up sheets of brown or gray paper.)
- 📖 Knights of North Castle Complete Music CD or MP3 files
- 📖 CD player or device to play downloaded music

## Bible Storyteller

### Session Three

-  Bible or Bible App for smartphone/tablet
-  Storyteller costume—This could be typical “Renaissance Fest” attire (billowy shirt, puffy hat with feather, etc.; tights optional). Modern attire also may work, especially when paired with a Knights of North Castle **Leader T-Shirt** and **Guide Vest**.
-  Bible—The Storyteller could hold a Bible that looks very old and has fancy lettering. (Consider designing a “prop” Bible from cardboard so that it is lighter.)
-  Bible-times attire for Joseph—simple robe or tunic, beard
-  Bible-times attire for Mary—blue robe, head covering (optional)
-  Bible-times attire for Shepherds 1 and 2—same as Joseph, but with shepherds’ crooks and no beards
-  angels 1, 2, and 3—white robes, wings and/or halos
-  Create a manger using a box, brown towels and a small blanket.
-  Bethlehem “skyline” for backdrop or use Transparency 21: Scene 3
-  Sign listing Christmas carols, which are embedded in the drama script: “O Little Town of Bethlehem,” “Away in a Manger,” “It Came upon the Midnight Clear,” “O Holy Night,” “Hark! the Herald Angels Sing,” “Joy to the World,” “Silent Night,” “O Come, All Ye Faithful,” “Go, Tell It on the Mountain.”
-  Knights of North Castle Complete Music CD or MP3 files
-  CD player or device to play downloaded music

### Session Four















-  Bible or Bible App for smartphone/tablet
-  Storyteller costume—This could be typical “Renaissance Fest” attire (billowy shirt, puffy hat with feather, etc.; tights optional). Modern attire also may work, especially when paired with a Knights of North Castle **Leader T-Shirt** and **Guide Vest**.

-  Assorted baskets containing the leftover bread and fish
-  cardboard boat (Can just be the side/profile. It should be long enough to look like it could carry four people.) Or use Transparency 22: Scene 4 as an option.
-  lake waves—4-5 yards of sheer blues fabric
-  Knights of North Castle Complete Music CD or MP3 files
-  CD player or device to play downloaded music
-  Transparency 20: Scene 2

-  Bible-times attire for Prisoners 1 and 2—tattered robes or tunics
-  jail cell door—large piece of cardboard cut with vertical bars, painted black
-  shackles—paper chains made from black paper
-  scallop shell for baptism
